

Invitation to High-Performance Materials at the ISOPE 2019 at Hilton Hawaiian Village Conference, Honolulu, Hawaii, June 16-21, 2019

On behalf of the ISOPE-2019 TPC, we invite you to submit an abstract for possible presentation at the 29th International Ocean and Polar Engineering Conference, Honolulu, Hawaii, June 16-21, 2019.

In addition to strong sessions on existing popular ISOPE topics, such as hydrodynamics, coastal engineering, ocean technology, etc., next year we will promote additional specialty symposia on emerging topics in addition to:

Ocean Technology, Hydrodynamics, AI, Digitalization, Underwater Technology, Arctic Science and Technology, Arctic Materials, Cryogenic Materials, Nanomaterials, Remote Sensing, Offshore Wind and Ocean Energy and Storage, Environment, Tsunami and Safety, Sloshing, LNG Bunkering/Storage, CFD, VIV, Advanced Ship Tech, High-performance Materials, Strain-based Design, Asset Integrity, Offshore and Arctic Pipeline, Deepwater Development, Frontier Energy Tech, Gas Hydrates and Ocean Mining, Subsea, Pipelines, Umbilicals, Installation, and more.

The advance author registration fee remains low, starting from tentatively \$690 for members, which includes the 4-volume proceedings, plus reception, banquet and coffee breaks. The 2019 conference proceedings will be available during the conference.

Since ISOPE-1992, the annual ISOPE conferences have been the world's largest technical conferences of their kind with peer-reviewed papers. Since the all-time record-breaking 1350+ abstracts received for ISOPE-2010 Beijing, the ISOPE-2015 Kona Conference broke the record again with 1,750+ abstracts, and upon peer-review, 867 papers were accepted for the conference proceedings, and 1,450+ abstracts for ISOPE-2018 Sapporo. The number of sessions has remained at 148-188 sessions with an emphasis on timely topics from 48-54 countries (www.isopec.org). ISOPE-2019 is being organized and hosted by the International Society of Offshore and Polar Engineers (ISOPE) with 31 cooperating organizations and societies from around the world.

All manuscripts are peer-reviewed prior to final acceptance. All ISOPE conference and symposium proceedings papers are indexed by Engineering Index, EI (Compendex), Scopus, Google Scholar, Thomson ISTP and others. ISOPE papers are available through online digital subscription from major academic and industry libraries worldwide.

- Abstract deadline: October 20, 2018
- Manuscript (for review) deadline: January 15, 2019 or earlier
- Final manuscript is due: March 24, 2019
